Code of Good Funeral Practices

As Funeral Directors our calling imposes upon us a special responsibility to those we serve, and to the public at large, chief among them is the obligation to inform the public so that everyone can make knowledgeable decisions about the final arrangements of their deceased loved ones.

To help you understand.....It is your right, and our desire, that you have as complete an understanding as possible regarding the cost of your services. The biggest factor is the time element in terms of our personnel and the use of the funeral home facilities. The maintenance of this service is unending; that is, it must be available 24 hours every day of the year. Many phases of our work are apparent while others are not. It is important to realize that no two funerals are exactly alike. Traditions, customs, social standing, personal feelings, financial ability and a multitude of other factors influence each funeral. Our services must conform to each individual family's wishes and their personal and religious needs.

Generally Funerals are divide into five categories; Professional Services, Use of the Facilities, Merchandise, Cash Disbursements and Transportation. Each category is discussed in detail below.

Professional Services

Meeting with a family to secure vital statistic information, obtain obituary information, complete itemized cost agreement, select a casket and vault of their choice and oversee all aspects of the funeral. To coordinate times of the following services as needed; Clergy, fraternal organizations, necessary automotive equipment for the convenience of the family, hairdresser, cemetery or crematory, vault company, veterans and civic associations. These services require an average of approximately 80 work hours per funeral. The funeral director and staff will provide assistance to the family. Completion the death certificate with vital statistics, to obtain signature and medical information from the attending physician or medical examiner, to file the completed and signed certificate with the registrar of vital statistics in municipalities where death occurred and obtain burial permit and certified copies if possible. Completion of all necessary form required by law. To answer all telephone calls and provide funeral information. The preparation and care of the deceased including embalming, shampooing, shaving, dressing and casketing, applying cosmetics, hairdressing, arrangement of flowers. Funeral Director and staff will attend all calling hours and funeral services.

Use of Facilities

Fixed overhead is calculated by the sum of all expenses per year divided by the number of services that were held in a given year. Included in the fixed overhead are as follows: taxes, specialized education, surgical supplies, facility and supply maintenance, administrative expenses, advertising, donations, utilities, personal and business insurance, capital improvements for the facility both interior and exterior use of the preparation room for embalming , dressing, disinfection and sanitization of remains and application of cosmetics to the deceased.

Merchandise

The casket of your choice, vault, clothing if purchased from the funeral home, memorial book, acknowledgement and prayer cards, contribution envelopes, crucifix/cross and rosary beads.

Cash Disbursements

All cash advances for church and cemetery will be paid by the next of kin.

Transportation

The complete cost of depreciation of hearse and service cars for the clients we serve.

SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF

\$2,500

Our fee for the basic service of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to, personnel available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year, consultation with family and responsible parties before, during, and after the arrangement conference, arrangement of funeral, preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits, recording vital statistics, and coordination with those that provide other portions of the funeral (e.g., clergy, cemetery, crematory, vault company, and others as required). Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facilities such as professional licensing, legal and accounting fees, insurance, building and utility expenses, parking lot and grounds, maintenance, taxes, equipment, furnishings, inventory costs, record keeping, and secretarial and administrative expenses.

EMBALMING

\$975

Includes the use of Massachusetts registered embalming preparation room in compliance with Federal EPA, OSHA, and most recent medical waste regulations. This fee also includes a Massachusetts Certified Embalmer to perform embalming procedure. Except in certain special cases, (i.e. delayed burial) embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial

Our services include set-up of visitation area, placement of encased remains, and display of floral arrangements, supervision of and attendance during visitation.

Our services include the coordination of funeral arrangements, supervision of Funeral and staff to attend the Funeral ceremony. Includes same day viewing/visitation prior to service.

Use of Staff & Facility for Memorial Service \$675

Our services include the coordination of the Memorial Service arrangements, supervision of the Memorial Service and use of staff to attend the Service. Includes same day visitation prior to service

Use of Staff for Graveside Service or Veterans' Cemetery Service \$375

Our services include the accompaniment of the Remains to the Cemetery, supervision of the Graveside Service and staff to attend the Service.

RECEIVING REMAINS FROM ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME

This charge includes temporary shelter of the remains, transportation of remains to cemetery, necessary services of funeral director and staff.

IMMEDIATE BURIALS

Our charge for immediate burial with an attendant during burial includes the removal and shelter of the remains. Also included in our charge is the transportation to the cemetery, necessary services of the funeral director and staff and any authorizations required.

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IMMEDIATE CREMATION

Our charge for immediate cremation without an attendant during the ceremony includes professional services, removal of remains, local transportation to the crematory, necessary services of funeral director and staff and authorizations. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can choose an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body (with or without an outside covering). We provide a plywood base with a cardboard cover. The above charge does not include advances to outside parties or merchandise.

MEDICAL SCHOOL ANATOMICAL DONATIONS

This service includes limited basic services of funeral director and administrative staff to obtain legal documents and other paperwork. This charge does not include the use of the facility for Funeral Ceremony or cash advances. \$825

MASSACHUSETTS STATE REIMBURSED BURIAL/CREMATION

The state of Massachusetts will pay up to \$1100 for a Funeral/Cremation that does not exceed \$3,500 for those who qualify for Mass Health. The next of kin is responsible for the remainder of the cost. In addition, the next of kin must contact Mass Health directly for the eligibility of the deceased. Mass Health will not disclose confidential information to the Funeral Home.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

A Deposit of 50% is needed at the conclusion of arrangement conference, cash, personal check, bank check or credit card. Payment In Full is due at the conclusion of services. Payment is to be made no later than 30 days from date of death. Interest of 1.5% per month will be charged to accounts past due. Purchaser agrees to pay all costs of collections including reasonable attorney fees.
